"She kept saying this is a kids' party," says the friend of the twice-rehabbed star, who was hospitalized in January (after which her father took conservatorship over her).

And Britney, who some pals say is prone to loneliness, was the life of the party. "She was in the bounce house when one kid made a poo, and she changed the diaper," one attendee says. "She could not have been

happier or more hands-on. She was in a great mood. The whole family was in a great mood. It was completely celebratory."

And after a bitter custody battle that saw her lose and slowly regain access to her sons (a July settlement entitles her to more overnight visits this fall), the kids were happy. "When she is at her best, Britney is an amazing mother," Lynne writes of Britney, whose album *Circus* is due December 2, her birthday. Those close to the star agree. "She adores her children.
